#### PHR 2018


- Best participation in 10 years (18 hospitals)
- 15 provincial hospitals, 2 district hospitals (Kompiam, Mambisanda), plus Gerehu
- Nearly 25,000 admissions
- Edilson visited every hospital

### Lowest overall CFR in 7 years

18 hospitals24,960 admissions1676 deaths

CFR = 6.71

Compared with all previous years a significant difference Cumulative CFR 7.4%





years 11.33




#### Severe malnutrition

Consistent fall in CFR for severe malnutrition 2548 admissions 315 deaths

CFR = 12.4%


Cumulative CFR previous years 17.7%



## Neonatal mortality rate


Slow fall in CFR for neonatal admissions: 7725 admissions 643 deaths CFR = 8.3%

Cumulative CFR previous years 9.72%



### Neonatal and perinatal care


- Birth asphyxia 1812 admissions, 245 deaths (CFR 13.5%). Birth asphyxia accounted for 38% of all neonatal deaths
- Very low birth weight (1000-1499): 536 admissions; 217 died (40.5%)



Very low birth weight (1000-1499g)

2175 children admitted with tuberculosis 189 deaths CFR = 8.69%.

EPTB 13.5% PTB 4.7%



### Why have there been improvements?

- More paediatricians in the provinces, since 2010, about 10 additional paediatricians working in the provinces
- Training on SAM, and Hospital Care for Children
- EENC should improve neonatal outcomes in the coming years
- Better availability of oxygen and oximetry
- Changes in epidemiology of pneumonia, meningitis

#### PHR future

- V12 completed and tested, start using 1st January 2020.
- Maternal and newborn component
- Keep it stable for 3-5 years?
  - + Child protection data from Family Support Centres?
  - + HIV outcome data from clinics?
- Sustainability
  - Funding for Paediatric Surveillance Officer, travel
  - Production of Annual Report, printing and distribution
